I was pleased that information on future activities for H&I and for the Sac Fellowship was presented at admin and will be further discussed here tonight. We are entering our third year in existence and are still below our prudent reserve. We have additional NA services such as Phone Line and H&I to support, as well as more expense if we decide to go to monthly schedule printings. Perhaps since we have these additional services, we can find a way to increase 7th tradition donations to the Area so we can support these services. The issue of the 7th tradition will be discussed further tonight.

I will be interested in hearing from the GSRs how the Penny a Day order form worked out for you. These are an important fundraiser for the Area and both old-timers and newcomers are encouraged to participate in supporting the Sac Fellowship by buying a pin. This Area activity is donating over \$250 tonight.
