## PR Coordinator Report

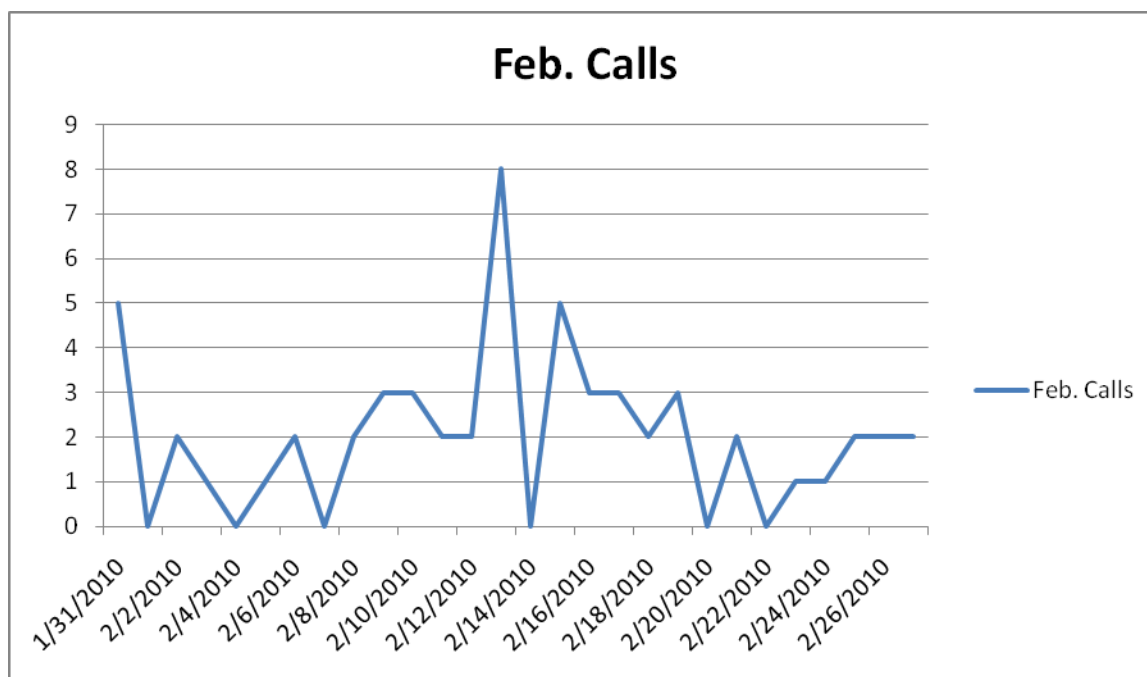
