VII. Brainstorming & Dialogue

A. Paper and plastic products:

-There are leftover products (paper cups and plates) from past events that are currently being held in storage. At the last admin meeting, a member of a specific group asked came to ask if they could use these products for their upcoming event. The admin team told him that we could not grant the permission, that he would need to bring it to the ASC so the GSRs could make that decision.
