In the coming weeks, task-oriented working groups will set out to accomplish the three Public Relations tasks identified at the last ASC and we'll hold our first FUN-raiser. Cool!

### **Please forgive me and accept my amends...**

I sincerely apologies for misplacing a few of the volunteer contact lists collected last spring. Thank you for helping me to right that wrong by passing around another list and announcing opportunities to help with the Spaghetti Dinner and PR tasks.

### **Meeting w/ARANA on Sharing Services**

The final meeting of the ARANA ad hoc group exploring shared services was held this month. Below, you'll find excerpts from the final report which will be considered at American River's ASC meeting next Friday. It's my understanding that next steps would include a motion from one of their GSRs which will likely be referred to groups. Our November ASC falls after American River's in November, so we should have something to report and consider next month.

#### **Excerpts from the Shared Services ARANA Ad hoc Committee Report**

*It's recommended that all shared solutions would be on a trial basis to be reviewed at the ARANA yearly inventory.*

#### **3 OPTIONS FOR SCHEDULES:**

- Schedule contents stay the same with one exception on the header/ title -- a one line acknowledgement for the Sacramento Fellowship on the schedule title. Areas will be billed separately. (This solution was the most favored by the committee for fulfilling our primary purpose and promoting responsible use of NA funds.)
- Generic title, contents stay the same and separate billing.
- Two separate schedules with same info, separate subcommittees and separate headers. Separate billing.

#### **2 OPTIONS FOR PHONELINES:**

- 1 phone# for both areas. Both areas share costs 50/50. Sacramento Fellowship would elect a liaison for the purpose of communicating with the ARANA to keep the schedule up to date. Change the recording on the hotline to acknowledge the Sac Fellowship. (It was the general consensus that this solution best served our primary purpose.)
- Complete separation.

#### **3 OPTIONS FOR H & I:**

- 1 Committee with shared costs prorated based on # of NA meetings within each area. Budget to be approved by both areas.
- 1 committee for the 2 areas to share all H&I literature costs 50/50.
- 2 separate committees with agreed boundaries with a gradual redistribution of facilities.

### **Relatedly...**

American River has established another ad hoc committee to revisit the geographic boundaries they suggest in their guidelines. Doing so need not effect what ASC any group chooses to be served by since all groups are autonomous. I will attend the committee's second meeting on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of October, as requested.

- Flier is great idea for people to contact Carlos to get tickets
- Concerned about doing an event without a budget
- Can print tickets in books of ten so many people can sell
- Need to start at 5pm in order to end by 9
- We should ask groups about their interest and get a sense of how many people will attend
  - Last month we proposed/accepted the idea of having an activity
- Speaker after we eat? Yes
- Like the proposal but where will the money come from? Let's allocate funds for this event. At the next meeting, Carlos can bring a budget breakdown. Maybe \$300-400 total costs. Probably need to sell 60 tickets to break even.
- Can we establish a budget of \$400 to fund this event?
  - Proposal amended to include \$400 budget.
- What's the rush? Do we need to have this in November?
  - This Area doesn't even have a budget.
  - But we can still have a fundraiser.
