Location, location, location

Starting next month we'll be meeting at Evelyn Moore Community Center, 1402 Dickson Street in Sacramento. Please note that we will not meet again until January 9 (the second Wednesday). With this exception, the ASC will continue to meet on the first Wednesday of the month from 7 to 9:30 pm— we've booked the facility through the new year. Agenda meetings will be held in the same facility on 3rd Wednesdays from 7-9 pm.

Hospitals & Institutions

ARANA's admin has asked their H & I committee to discuss their vision for H & I's future and develop a proposal that could be considered by both Areas. The H & I Chair Steve has joined us tonight to give you an update and get some input from you.

PI/PR

I spoke with AR's PI Chair David, who assured me that:

- 1) They will continue to have an 800 number. They have had some trouble with getting 1-800-600- HOPE on the new (cheaper) plan, but have other 800 numbers available for use. Worst case scenario would mean that callers would be directed to call another number.
- 2) The current phonenumber plan pays for up to 2,000 minutes. An average of 1,000 calls come in monthly. Minutes over 2,000 are charged at 6¢ a minute.

I discussed a proposal out of our agenda meeting to pay for minutes over our plan (see Proposal 1). He believes it would be highly unlikely that we would generate that many more calls, but thought that the gesture would be well-received. He also tells me that his committee loves the postering campaign and plans to do some postering themselves. Finally, he encouraged membership on AR's PI committee by a liaison or two to maintain communication and see that Sac Fellowship's interests are represented. They meet on the 3rd Thursday of the each at 6:30pm at 3120 Cottage Way in Conference Room A or B.

Shared Services: especially phonenumber and PI

- Last month's ad hoc report (from our Chair) generated no motions at ARANA ASC.
- Do we want to make one more attempt to discuss coordinated services with ARANA?
 - We need to do something to get started
- Why would we not just advertise and see what happens?
- Lots of technology to apply to the phonenumber.
- Would love to see shared services, it's the definition of Unity. We must be careful not to lose our primary purpose. Old resentments are starting to wear down and there is some willingness to work with us around shared services. Allow a loving higher power to influence your decisions about what to do.
- Shared phonenumber makes the most sense. Having multiple numbers would be confusing to the newcomer. Worried that ARANA is thinking about shutting down the 800 number. If the phone bill is too much, the Area will pay for it.

 - Mills Station is too small, would like to eliminate that as a consideration
 - Does E Moore center have a kitchen/water? They have a place for literature but not sure if there's a kitchen. But we can get water for the coffee pot.
 - Sierra 2 is the size of this room. E Moore Center room is roughly the size of this room.
 - Sierra 2 is right off the freeway and may be more central but parking is terrible there.
 - We should not be worried about location. We'd drive anywhere to get dope.
 - What is Admin's budget for rooms? \$120 for both rooms (two meetings)
 - We need space to grow and E. Moore center is large. The place in Rancho is small.

Call for consensus: One person for Sierra 2, all others for Evelyn Moore
Is 75/month okay? Yes, agreed.

- Investigate what would be involved if we started our own PhoneLine.
- Can we investigate the price of extra minutes?
- Likes the idea of having a new phone line. Called the other line and no one answered.

- We shouldn't jump to conclusions that American River won't let us use their phonenumber. No opposition to investigating. Who would like to take the lead in this? Cindy volunteered.
