**Proposal 3:** To host a picnic, meeting, and white water rafting trip as follows:

- When? Sunday, July 13, 2008 – 11 am meeting, BYO lunch, rafts launch at 12:30
- Where? Picnic, meeting, and launch at River’s Bend Resort off highway 49 between Auburn & Placerville; raft the Gorge Run on the South Fork of the American River to Salmon Falls.
- Why? Fun & fellowship
- How? Pay as we go. \$89 per rafter. Group discount earned for every 11 paid participants will more than cover costs, remainder will be donated to SacFNA. Rafters will be required to sign an “assumption of risk and release of liability agreement” naming SacFNA, NorCal Region of NA, and NAWS as well as the rafting company, the State of CA, etc.
- Budget: \$15 insurance, \$35 fliers, \$15 mailing = \$65 total

Q. Are minors allowed.

A. Minimum age is 8 years old.

Q. Is there a minimum?

A. At 12 people we will make our money back.
