Q. How does the line item affect the budget?

A. We use the money that is from the can and spend then supplement with the area budget.

Q. How does the money get collected for area?

A. The money is given as donation and added to the area bank account and disbursed to region for H&I Literature.

Q. What increase has happened at area to request the additional funding?

A. H&I have reviewed the treasurer's report and the region is getting more money so we are requesting more money to help meet the needs of this area before forwarding money.

Q. Do H&I have a budget to work from?

A. The budget is \$300 that the area has allocated plus any additional monies that are collected by the cans. The can money has averaged approx. \$500.

Q. Do you budget money for each facility?

A. Not at this time. But we are willing to work on this

H&I is one way to help carry the message and it is nice to leave literature behind. For lock down facilities we do not leave books only IP's, White books and Schedules.

V. Brainstorming & Dialogue

Review ARANA Liaison Position: 12/03/2008 – Action Item to review ARANA Liaison position at April 2009 ASC. We were asked to review the position of Liaison at the April ASC to see if we wanted to continue the position. This will be brought to the September ASC.

Recovery Happens event discussion:

Don't think that if we only sit in a booth, we are not violating traditions.

Sponsored by political action groups and recovery groups and our traditions state we do not affiliate with any outside organizations.

We need to verify what the intent of the event is and not to identify us with the event.

An NA meeting is held at the event every year in the capital. Where does that fall into traditions?

The difference is that this is a political rally that is sponsored by political action groups and that is not correct.

Mather community campus was asked to host the meetings since they are a recovery transitional living.

Our PACT meeting is at a law enforcement agency yet this is ok.

Test for consensus: There was consensus to send the RCM to region with a vote that we do not support this as an area and that this is a violation of traditions.

Prudent use of NA funds (\$10,000) sending the RSC on the road:

The money set aside is a squandering of NA funds and should not be used. In fact would like to have the money that was set aside to be rescinded and put back in the treasury.

The reason that the region was doing this was to let the outlying areas know that they are important and show unity. We should allow the travelling RSC to continue.

The money would be used for gas for 1 car and one room for each area. The money also was being used to rent meeting rooms for the RSC.

Money not spent will be given back to the budget.

RCM's will take the group conscious to region.
