 - Q. Could this be changed to be more specific?
 - A. A new version of the line including the language to recommend not allowing the GSR to be both Admin and a GSR was included.
This was not specific enough and could lead to interpretation.
Would like it to read that once elected, the GSR can not be a both.
Admin Asst updated the guidelines to be very specific.
Change to: Admin members can not serve concurrently as GSR's.
Guidelines were tested for consensus with amendment:
