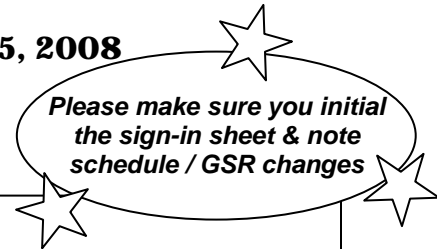

### ▪ Help line

ARANA has been referring addicts to meeting in our area.

Q. Can an area bring a proposal to region to create a regional phone line.

A. We can, and discussion would be held at region.

San Diego region is using this and it is working down there.

Gary discussed how it was done in Arizona.

Q. How does Arizona do it?

A. There are 3 areas that are in the Phoenix Tri-Area. There are about 150 groups. There are 2 and 4 hour slots and they fill to get a person to handle the slots.

There are currently people from SacFNA who are volunteers for ARANA.

Volunteer called ARANA helpline looking for ASC for SacFNA. They did not have the information.

Q. What is the helpline for?

A. The helpline is to help an addict find a meeting whether for the first time or any other time.

Jon would prefer one helpline for the Sacramento Area and not two. Jon has also volunteered to be part of discussion.

Kevin looked into services to get our own line. One is called One Box that is connected to your home computer.

We would still need volunteers to answer the phone and workshops to show people how to work the phonenumber.

Kevin feels that we should be proactive and look at creating our own.

Eric does not want to wait for ARANA to make a decision. We should be able to get the information from other areas and provide the service as well with other areas information. We can have an automated and live addict hybrid phonenumber to allow the information to be provided for the addict looking for a meeting.

Just back from vacation, went to Florida. Call phonenumber in the phonebook – wrong area, but they had #s for whole state. We can refer to other areas, other meetings. That's how we need to be - proactive and not reactive.
